

ATRSC EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

WHO CAN APPLY:

- Applicant must be a high school senior or older, with no upper age limit.
- Applicant must show proof of a high school diploma or GED.
- Applicant must show proof of acceptance in any type of post high school educational institution.
- Applicant must be a current member of the ATRSC for three consecutive years.
- Applicant must show at a minimum of 2 Tan sanctioned ARBA shows for each year of membership.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Member must fill out the ATRSC application, which must be postmarked by 7/15.
- The application must include a short (1 typed page) essay detailing applicant's goals and future plans.
- Application must be accompanied by a copy of the high school diploma or GED.
- Application must be accompanied by 2 letters of recommendation, and at least 1 must be from a current ARBA judge.
- Application will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and a decision will be made by 10/1.
- Winners will be announced at the ARBA National Convention.

DETAILS:

- 1 or 2 scholarships, of a minimum amount of \$100 each will be awarded.
- The committee has the right to award either 1 or 2 scholarships based on the quality of the applications received.
- The amount of each scholarship will be determined based on the net profit from the prior year's convention raffle (at the club booth).
- Once selected, the scholarship recipient must provide grades or a letter from the school, certifying attendance at the institution. This must be sent to the scholarship committee and postmarked by 12/31 of the year in which the scholarship was awarded. Once this letter is received, the money will be awarded directly to the recipient.
- The scholarship committee will select an alternate winner if possible from the applicants, in case the winner cannot or does not provide attendance certification. The alternate will not be notified unless he/she becomes eligible to receive the scholarship
- The scholarship can only be received one time, but the member may apply more than once.

SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW COMMITTEE:

The committee to review and act on all applications shall consist of the ATRSC President, 2 ATRSC officers or directors, 1 member at large, and 1 ARBA member unaffiliated with the club, selected by the ATRSC President. All committee members will act on all applications for a given year.
